The Real Inclusion Kit for community groups and organisations' aims to increase the capacity of organisations to provide for the involvement of Deaf and hard of hearing people. The resource provides strategies that are accessible, simple and 'easy to use'. It includes stories and communication tools and resources that increase the ability of community groups, clubs and organisations to plan and resource the inclusion and community connectedness for Deaf and hard of hearing people.
